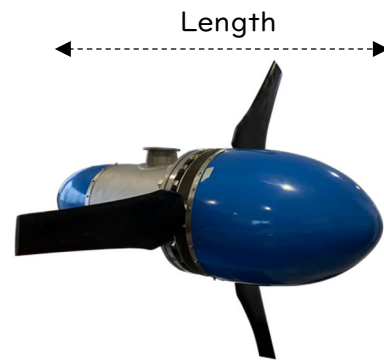


Fig 2. Turbine generator

## Demonstration Facility

A floating platform “Bluenergy Station” is moored 400 meters offshore from the Raffles Lighthouse to supply electricity generated by turbine generators through an underwater cable to the lighthouse. This facility is operated automatically and can be monitored remotely from the mainland.

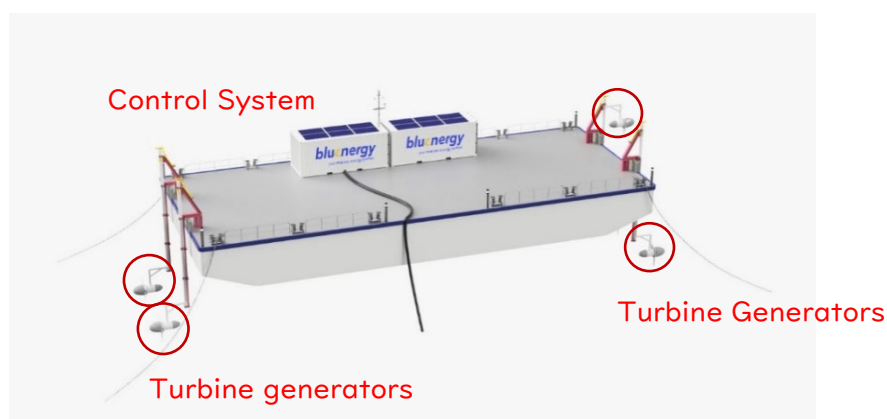


Fig 3. Bluenergy Station (image)
